REGISTRATION:

For parade pass and free park admission for the day, you must pre-register by OCTOBER 3, 2008. All entries received after October 3, 2008 and all day-of entries will be allowed to march in the parade but will not receive free entry to the park and will not be eligible for judging.

Special note regarding camping: There is no charge to enter the parade, however, camp site reservation is completely independent of parade registration and can be made by calling 1-800-TO-Calico.

Special Note: If you are a registered parade participant you will be allowed to carry an unloaded vintage, period, or replica firearm as part of your parade costume as long as you are visibly wearing your Calico Days Parade registration badge.

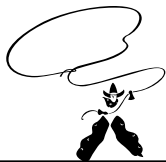
